Course Description:

Beginning Strings offers instruction on violin, viola, cello, and string bass with a focus on the skills necessary for long-term success. Fundamentals stressed include proper posture and playing position, development of characteristic tone quality, and training in music literacy. This group will perform in the Spring Concert.

Course Objectives:

- 1. The student will develop an understanding of their role as a member of a performance ensemble.
- 2. The student will develop an understanding of their role in support of community and church functions.
- 3. The student will develop and continue to articulate their musical ability through the use of small ensembles and cooperative learning groups.
- 4. The student will work towards learning and mastery of beginning music skills.

Participation:

- Students must be prepared for assigned work (practice assigned music at home and come to class with music prepared).
- Students must attend all rehearsals and concerts.
